- ___ 1. Cut away from your body and others when using knives.
- ___ 2. Use kitchen knives to cut food as well as pry open a can, saw cardboard boxes and tighten a screw.
- ___ 3. Wash knives one by one and keep them separate from other dishes so that they aren't hidden.
- ___ 4. Wipe spills off the floor after you are finished cooking and it is time to clean up.
- ___ 5. Open a pan lid by tilting the lid up from the back of the pan. This method lets the steam escape away from you and prevents steam burns.
- ___ 6. When you're finished cooking, leave the stove on until you are sure your food is cooked.
- ___ 7. When trying to put out a kitchen fire, use water or carry your pan to the sink.
- ___ 8. If something seems wrong with an appliance, unplug it and have a teacher examine it.
- ___ 9. Use spray products only in well ventilated areas. Point the spray nozzle away from you. Never spray toward other people or inhale the spray yourself.
- ___ 10. You don't need to sit down and eat. Running or talking will never cause you to swallow food before it is well chewed.
- ___ 11. Store aerosol sprays in a cool place. These products are under pressure. Heat can cause their containers to explode.
- ___ 12. Only use a charcoal grill outside. It produces a deadly gas called carbon monoxide. Outside this colorless odorless gas can disperse. Inside, it is trapped by the walls and can build up and kill you.
- ___ 13. If you burn yourself, put the burned area under cool water or wrap ice in a clean cloth and place it on the burned area.
- ___ 14. If someone is electrically shocked, disconnect the appliances that caused the shock. Use a wooden broom or a dry cloth to do this. Do not use metal.
